Dog Costume Event Introduction

The BCYF Dog Costume Event demonstrates the exhibitor's team's theatrical costume skills.

Dog Costume Event Purpose

To have fun!

Is Dog Costume a Major Event?

Dog Costume Event is not a major event.

TR (Traditional) and NTR (Non-Traditional) Exhibitor Definition

- 1. **TR** is the abbreviation for a traditional exhibitor (*Refer to Exhibitor's Definitions, Abbreviations & Age of Dept.* 22; *Dogs in the Exhibitor Handbook*).
- 2. **NTR** is the abbreviation for a non-traditional exhibitor (*Refer to Exhibitor's Definitions, Abbreviations & Age of Dept. 22; Dogs in the Exhibitor Handbook*).

Berrien County Youth Fair Premiums

BCYF premiums will not be given for the Dog Costume Event.

Dog Costume Event Divisions 1 (TR) and 2 (NTR)

There are two Dog Costume Event divisions with three classes in each division.

- 1. Division 1: Traditional Dog Costume The classes for Division 1 are:
 - COS TR Juniors (age 5-9)
 - COS TR Intermediates (age 10-13)
 - COS TR Seniors (age 14-20)

2. Division 2: Non-Traditional Dog Costume - The classes for Division 2 are:

- COS NTR Juniors (age 5-12)
- COS NTR Intermediate (age 13-19)
- COS NTR Seniors (age 20-26)

Dog Costume Event General Rules

- TR and NTR exhibitors must have registered for the Dog Costume Event on or before July 1st.
- 2. The exhibitor may enter only one (1) dog in Costume Event.
- 3. The exhibitor shall have an active part in the preparation of the team's costumes.
- 4. The costume can be homemade or store bought.
- 5. The dog will remain on leash while in and/or outside of the costume ring.

6. Dog Costume Card -

- a. On the day of the costume event, the exhibitor must prepare and return a
 completed **Dog Costume Card** to the Dog Registration Desk no later than one
 (1) hour prior to judging.
- b. Dog costume card will be used by the Costume Ring Master for announcing the exhibitor team's costume theme as the team parades in front of the judges.
- 7. **NTR Team Instructors** NTR Team Instructors may not dress up in costume but may walk with and assist the exhibitor with his or her dog.
- 8. **BCYF Back Tag Identification** BCYF back tag identification shall be worn on the outermost back of the exhibitor's costume.

Costume Judging Guidelines

- 1. JUDGE'S DECISIONS ARE FINAL.
- 2. The exhibitor and dog will be judged as one (1) unit.
- 3. The exhibitor's team may show only once in the class he or she has registered in.
- 4. Judges will base his or her decisions upon the
 - a. Theme of the costumes.
 - b. Originality of the costumes.
 - c. Quality of the costumes.
- 5. Judges may ask questions of the exhibitor on
 - a. What inspired the exhibitor to choose his or her theme of costume?
 - b. How the costume was made?
 - c. What materials were used?

Awards

- 1. Class Placement Awards
 - a. Division 1 (TR) Class Placement Class rosettes for 1st through 6th place will be offered.
 - b. **Division 2 (NTR) Class Placement -** Class rosettes for 1st through 6th place will be offered.

2. Best Costume Grand Champion for TR and NTR Divisions

- a. Best Costume Grand Champion for Division 1 (TR)
 - Judges will review the first-place winner from each TR class and choose the one team he or she thinks deserves the award of Best TR Costume Grand Champion.
 - 2. Only one exhibitor from Division 1 will be recognized as the Best Costume Grand Champion.
- b. Best Costume Grand Champion for Division 2 (NTR)
 - 1. Judges will review the first-place winners from each NTR class and choose the one team he or she thinks deserves the award of Best NTR Costume Grand Champion.
 - 2. Only one exhibitor from Division 2 will be recognized as the Best Costume Grand Champion.
