## BERRIEN COUNTY YOUTH FAIR NON-TRADITIONAL COSTUME JUDGE'S RULES AND INSTRUCTIONS:

## NON-TRADITIONAL COSTUME GENERAL RULES:

- 1. The NT (*non-traditional*) exhibitor shall have an active part in the preparation of the team's costumes.
- 2. One dog per NT Exhibitor.
- 3. Dog must be on a leash.
- 4. Dog and NT Exhibitor can only be shown once.
- 5. Dog and NT Exhibitor will be judged as one unit.
- 6. Costume will be judged on originality and quality.

## JUDGE'S INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. As this is not a BCYF "*Premium*" class, the judge does not have to worry about class placements or A, B or C premium ribbons. Just have fun!
- 2. Each nontraditional exhibitor will receive an "*Honorable Mention*" Themed Rosette for his or her efforts in the making of the canine's and his or her costume.
- 3. ONLY ONE EXHIBITOR WILL BE RECOGNIZED BY THE BCYF COSTUME JUDGE AS NON-TRADITIONAL DOG COSTUME GRAND CHAMPION.

## **COSTUME JUDGING INSTRUCTIONS:**

- 1. Each exhibitor and his or her canine will parade in front of the judge individually.
- 2. After parading in front of the judge, the exhibitor will line up along the fence and place his or her Back Tag Number on the ground in front of them.
- 3. The judge will choose which themed rosette goes with which costume.
- 4. The judge will choose the NT Grand Champion Costume.
- 5. The judge will sign his or her name in the judge's signature box.
- 6. The judge will award the Themed Rosettes first.
- 7. The judge will award the Grand Champion Costume last.
