



BERRIEN COUNTY YOUTH FAIR REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS

SMALL ANIMAL (DOGS & CATS INCLUDED)

REGISTRATION DEADLINE IS JULY 1ST!

The four steps to exhibitor's registration for dog events:

STEP ONE - READING

1. **CANINE REGULATIONS** - Exhibitor must obtain and read the BCYF Canine Regulations. The canine regulations can be obtained from the BCYF Exhibitor Handbook which can be found
 - a. At the BCYF main office if you wish a printed copy of the whole handbook, or
 - b. BCYF Website at [Dog Department - Berrien County Youth Fair \(bcyf.us\)](http://Dog%20Department%20-%20Berrien%20County%20Youth%20Fair%20(bcyf.us)) and **click on Dog Handbook**.
2. **BCYF DOG EVENT(S) JUDGING PROGRAM, PROCEDURES AND GUIDELINES** - Exhibitor must obtain a copy and read the BCYF Dog Event(s) Judging Program, Procedures and Guidelines he or she wishes to enter. These printed judging programs can be obtained from
 - a. The BCYF main office.
 - b. Best Friends 4-H Club website at www.bf4hclub.com and click on Berrien County Youth Fair.

STEP TWO - REGISTRATION - MUST BE BCYF'S HANDS BY JULY 1ST!

Please note - If you are not sure what class you should enter, please email Co-Superintendent Mrs. Connie Peterson at conniep051@gmail.com for assistance. Exhibitor may register for his or her events and classes two ways...

1. **ONLINE REGISTRATION** - Exhibitor will go online to Blue Ribbon Fair Online located at blueribbonfair.com and follow the instructions. **Do not forget to email your dog's LABELED photos to entry@bcyf.org with DOG DEPT. 2021 ENTRY PHOTOGRAPHS on the subject line.**
2. **PAPER REGISTRATION** - You can obtain a paper Registration Form from the BCYF main office or download a copy at [Complete the registration form](#). **Make and keep a copy for yourself. Clip your dog's LABELED photos to the form and either**
 - a. Hand deliver to the BCYF main office personal,
 - b. Drop it in the mailbox in front of the office door, or
 - c. Mail to BCYF, P.O. Box 7, Berrien Springs, MI 49103.

STEP THREE - SUNDAY, ENTRY DAY

1. Exhibitor will need to affirm canine event classes and canine's immunizations at the BCYF Entry Office (Building 10) no later than 1:30 p.m. on Sunday of fair week.
2. Items to bring with you:
 - a. Copy of your canine entry form with canine's photographs attached.
 - b. Proof of your canine's immunizations.
3. You will have to sign a green BCYF Animal Certification Form at this time.
4. At this time exhibitor may sign up for
 - a. Overall Event Championship Awards
 - b. AG Olympics

STEP FOUR - VET CHECK

Exhibitor must have one canine health check before he or she can obtain his or her backtag. **Please review BCYF Canine Regulations; Section 10:Veterinarian Health Check in the Exhibitor Handbook.**

STEP FIVE - Do your best in the ring and don't forget to have FUN!
